### What are we going to do?

#### Silence, ça pousse !!

Inspired by nature and children's curiosity, we will explore the wonderful world of plants, flowers, and how things grow. Through hands-on activities, stories, and play, they will discover the magic of nature while being immersed in French in a joyful and caring environment.

Mornings will be dedicated to creative and cooking activities (arts & crafts / cooking), while afternoons will focus on worksheets, yoga, as well as sportive and language-based games.

From songs and storytelling to arts & crafts, cooking, sensory play, and creative experiments, each day is a new opportunity to learn and grow!



### Main activity

#### 🌱 Monday: Little gardeners!

Let's become little gardeners and discover how plants grow, what they need, and how to take care of them.

Morning and afternoon: planting seeds in a pot and activities to learn what plants need to grow, through vocabulary and sentence-building.

#### ☁️ Tuesday: Rain, sun... rainbow!

Let's explore how rain and sunshine come together to create a beautiful rainbow and discover the colours of nature.

Morning (craft): sensory rainbow creation.

Afternoon (worksheet): work on colour vocabulary, word recognition and spelling.

#### 🍓 Wednesday: It's growing!

Let's discover fruits and vegetables and learn how they grow, from the garden to our plate.

Morning (craft/cooking): cooking activity to make a strawberry tartlet.

Afternoon (worksheet): le potager – image description to learn vocabulary related to fruits and vegetables.

#### 🌸 Thursday: Beautiful flowers!

Let's dive into the world of flowers, exploring their shapes, colours and different parts.

Morning (craft): painting a dreamy meadow full of flowers.

Afternoon (worksheet): learning the names of flowers and describing their different parts (stems, leaves, petals, thorns, centre).

#### 🪴 Friday: Let's pot it!

Let's get creative and become potters!

Morning and afternoon: Modelling a plant pot.
