## Summer Camp – 27 to 31/07/26 (WEEK 2)

### What happens when learning a language with the Club Petit Pierrot® Programme

1. Practical language use in various contexts aids long-term retention and understanding.
2. Exposure to real situations makes the language more meaningful, easier to use and easier to memorise.
3. Children develop effective language learning strategies effortlessly.



With clear linguistic goals, every step of the morning is designed to enrich their vocabulary, oral expression and enhance their comprehension in French, without translation. Children are divided into smaller groups by age and French proficiency.

### What are we going to do?

Inspired by our fun and original French song **Que va-t-on faire aujourd'hui ?** The children will explore exciting holiday activities through stories, music, creative activities, play and games indoor and outdoor. Each day introduces a new adventure, helping children develop vocabulary and expressions linked to everyday outings and experiences.

Mornings will be dedicated to creative and cooking activities, while afternoons will focus on fun worksheets, yoga, as well as sportive and language-based games.



### Main activity

#### **Monday: Swinging at the park!**

Let's head to the playground and explore outdoor games and movements while discovering key vocabulary such as *je me balance*, *je glisse*, *je saute!*

**Morning (craft):** park-themed creative activity, with a focus on *la balançoire*.

**Afternoon (worksheet):** activities about different playground games, using sentence-building.

#### **Tuesday: Museum fun!**

Let's dive into the world of French painters and artistic expression, discovering different styles and creativity.

**Morning (craft):** create a painting artwork inspired by famous painters.

**Afternoon (worksheet):** work on self-portraits, describing and comparing them to real images.

#### **Wednesday: Zoo-tastic creatures!**

Let's explore the fascinating world of zoo animals through discovery and creative activities.

**Morning (craft):** sensory lion-themed creation.

**Afternoon (worksheet):** learn animal names and spelling through word searches games and crosswords.

#### **Thursday: Seaside fun, let's get building!**

Let's enjoy the seaside atmosphere while exploring sand, construction, and beach-related vocabulary.

**Morning (craft):** modelling a sandcastle.

**Afternoon (worksheet):** vocabulary linked to sandcastles, describing and/or completing sentences.

#### **Friday: A proper picnic!**

Let's discover the joy of a French-style picnic, sharing food and outdoor moments together.

**Morning (craft/cooking):** organise a French-style picnic with baguette sandwiches.

**Afternoon (worksheet):** create on a shopping list to organise a picnic.
