What happens when learning a language with the Club Petit Pierrot® Programme:

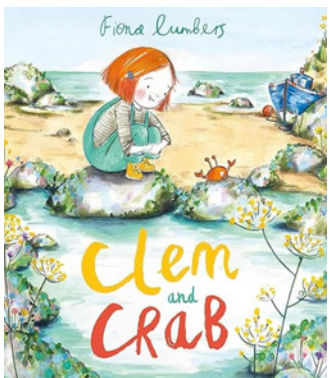
1. Practical language use in various contexts aids long-term retention and understanding.

What are we going to do?



Inspired by this tale *Clem et le crabe* the children will **explore vocabulary and embark on a week-long imaginary adventure** led by our expert native speaking French teachers.

Through this beautiful story, children discover the friendship between Clem and a little crab, while becoming aware of the importance of caring for wildlife and protecting the environment.

Monday – The Sea Collage

Children will create a seaside scene using paper, glue, and lots of imagination! Sands, waves, seagrass and colourful details will bring the ocean to life.

Tuesday – The Crab cooking activity

Time to cook! Children will create their own crab through a delicious cooking activity.

Wednesday – Aquarium painting

Children will create their own aquarium and paint the the different marine species.

Thursday - Recycling craft activity

After picking up a variety of recycled materials, children will create their own sea-life creation.

Friday – Story Time & Sequencing

We will retell the story together using sequencing activities, allowing children to rebuild it step by step and take it home.
