By following the tortoise's steady progress and the hare's mistakes, young readers understand that taking one's time and staying focused can lead to success, while also enjoying a timeless and amusing tale.



Monday – The hare & the tortoise made with salt dough

Children will create their own animals with salt dough after a messy workshop to make the dough.



Tuesday – The race gluing and painting activity

Children will recreate the race scene through gluing and painting activity.



Wednesday – The tortoise cooking activity

Time to cook! Children will create their own tortoise with fruits and homemade crêpes!



Thursday - The yarn tree

Let's practise our fine motors skills, decorating trees with some colourful yarn!



Friday – Story Time & Sequencing

We will retell the story together using sequencing activities, allowing children to rebuild it step by step and take it home.
