What happens when learning a language with our Immersion Programme:

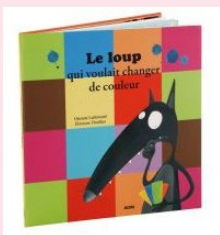
1. Practical language use in various contexts aids long-term retention and understanding.

What are we going to do?



Inspired by this tale **Le loup qui voulait changer de couleurs**, the children will explore vocabulary and embark on a week-long imaginary adventure led by our expert native speaking French teachers. Children will experiment with emotions, colours, and self-acceptance with interactive activities.

A week filled with fun, educational, and creative activities in French (**songs, stories, games, drama, messy play, arts & crafts, yoga, dancing...**) where children will be immersed in the language within a nurturing environment.

Children create a large, shared painting together.

Children learn about the alphabet and the days of the week.

🌸 Experimenting with salt dough and modelling a flower.

Thursday

✍️ Worksheet about colours and words.

Friday

📖 Story time and a craft activity with a mirror, to talk about emotions and self-acceptance.
